Mones Says...

Finally the day has come. For over 4 years I have been praying for our children and their connection with worship, and in that for them to be built up as a community who are deeply connected to the Father, fully aware of the presence of their Brother Jesus, and at home in the Holy Spirit. It took a while, but I believe that today, the launch of the service where the children and youth of our church will have their own worship service, ministering to each other with their leaders, expressing worship in a language and style which is relevant to them, will facilitate a deeper walk and intimacy with God.

On the 4th Sunday of every month, children and adults will have separate services, can I encourage you to make sure to be on time, and to give it a go. The Castle Rooms will be open from 10.45am, with initial fun activities aiming to start the worship as near as possible to 11.00am. One of the verses in scripture that has always struck a chord with me is the description of David - that he served God in his own generation. I believe with every fibre of my being that we all have the privilege of serving God in our generation, and children are no different than adults in that. They are also called to serve God and each other, yes from their younger days.

Over the years that I have been in ministry I have encountered worship settings specifically designed to facilitate the worship of children and teenagers, where the teenagers, after being equipped, were released to lead those who are younger than them. They modelled ministry to those who looked up to them and so they all gained confidence in their place in God, and so were able to minister to both and young and old. What a privilege for me it was to have encountered that, and to being ministered to by those who Jesus put up as an example to receiving the kingdom.

My prayer is that we will all support this service, singles, families with Children and Families without Children or with Children who left home, by prayer, by making sure that we start on time, and by offering to assist the leaders in any area that they need help.
