## **Mones Says...**

How amazing it is to be filled with the Holy Spirit! Throughout the whole bible we hear about and encounter those who were filled with the Spirit. Men and women who in the Old Testament were given the Holy Spirit for a specific calling and a specific task, but when we come to the New Testament the promise which was given by Joel is fulfilled, "I will pour out my Spirit, on all people" young and old, then they will receive dreams from me and see visions from me and will be able to do the same things as my Son did, and even greater things as Jesus did say, OH for the greater things.
